



Symbiosis International (Deemed University) is committed towards generation of knowledge, innovations and its contribution towards the development of the Nation.




FACULTY OF MEDICAL & HEALTH SCIENCES (FoHS)



Medical Education has undergone a paradigm shift over the last five years. Our pedagogy is no longer confined to the traditional "chalk and talk" way of teaching. We have implemented a more integrated and holistic approach through CBME. In anatomy learning, we are transitioning from theoretical anatomy to a more practical and clinical approach with the aid of technology-assisted learning. The rapid advancement in technology and artificial intelligence, at times, seems to threaten the hands-on teaching style of traditional cadaveric dissections. Yet, at other times, the age-old method of learning by touch and feel enjoys dominance. The occurrence of a worldwide pandemic amidst all of this necessitated a complete resort to online anatomy teaching-learning methods. The post-pandemic times thus brought about a healthy mix of live-interactive as well as technology-aided anatomy education, which emphasizes more on clinical skills and a much-needed integration with the other basic and clinical sciences. What does the future of anatomy look like? On day one, our expert speakers will speak on this very broad topic under the contexts of CBME, post-COVID anatomy teaching, and the use of e-learning in modern anatomy education.

Title: Should be in Title case, Bold Font, Font type - Times New Roman & Font size 14.

Author's Name: Should be in capital letters, Font Size 12 and the name of Presenting Author being bold and underlined.

Affiliation: Sentence case, Font Size 12

Contents: Should contain Background, Aim of the study, Material & Methods, Results and Conclusion. It should not exceed 250 words.
