1. **Title** should be in bold font, font type-Arial & font size 12. The first letter of each word should be in capital.
2. **Author/s, name/s** should be mentioned as surname followed by initials, bold Arial font, font size 12 and the name of presenting author should be underlined.
3. **Institution's name** should be in italics, font size 12.

B. **Contents** should contain objective, methods, results, conclusion and should not exceed 250 Words.

Abstract should be computer typed as MS Word document, font Arial and font size 12 with single spacing.

Abstracts without results will not be considered for presentation.

**RELIGIOUS PLACES/HISTORICAL PLACES IN AND AROUND UJJAIN:**



**Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga**

Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga is a Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva and is one of the twelve Jyotirlingas, shrines which are said to be the most sacred abodes of Shiva. It is located in the ancient city of Ujjain in the state of Madhya Pradesh, India. The temple is situated on the side of the holy river Shipra.



**Shree Harsiddhi Mata Shaktipith Temple**

Prayer halls with ornate, carved gopuram gates, a shrine with an eternal lamp & Maratha-era origins.



**Rajwada Palace**

Rajwada, also known as the Holkar Palace or Old Palace, is an important historical palace in Indore that was constructed by the Holkars of the Maratha empire, around 2 centuries ago.



**Gopal Mandir**

Stately, 19th-century temple with a silver-coated Krishna idol & surrounded by street-market stalls.



**Shri Chintaman Ganesh Temple, Ujjain**

Chintaman Ganesh is the biggest temple of Lord Ganesha in Ujjain of Madhya Pradesh, India. This temple is built across the Kshipra river on the Fatehabad railway line, and is located about 7 km far south-westerly to the Ujjain town. The temple is located now in the middle of the town's market.



**Khajrana Ganesh Mandir**

Khajrana Ganesh Temple is a Hindu temple complex, situated in Khajrana area of Indore in the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh, India. The main temple in the complex is dedicated to Lord Ganesha. It was built by Maharani Ahilyabai Holkar of the Holkar Dynasty.
