

What Is It?

An educational competition in which teams face off in scripted scenarios to demonstrate their clinical skills, teamwork, communication, and problem-solving abilities, in front of a large audience. Each team will be given unique emergency room scenarios which will have simulated patients. After the preliminary rounds, the top four teams will compete against each other in the final round for Resus Glory!



Objective



This type of learning emphasizes experiential learning, which involves the learner mentally, physically, and emotionally in the moment, whether it is a simulated experience, reliving the past, or through collaboration (community of practice). Every person involved can benefit from observing and reflecting on decision making, as well as viewing and discussing practice variations across disciplines and institutions.

What To Expect

Each team will be assessed separately in the preliminary round. You will be assessed on the dynamics of your team communications, clinical acumen, accuracy in interventions, continuum of care and disposition, and ability to take informed decisions. You will be taken through simulated Emergency Room scenarios and work with the most basic to the most advanced simulators in terms of realism.



Tips For Event Day



Arrive on time. Ensure your team members are present and ready. Pay attention to the prebrief and familiarize yourself with the simulated environment. Maintain situational awareness at all times, Huddle often to summarize what you know and what you are thinking. When a patient starts to deteriorate, go back to your ABCs. Most importantly, suspend your disbelief. Believe this is a real patient, & do what you will with a real patient.

Celebrate

Whether you take home the gold or not, this is a great experience and everyone will have learned something. You are learning in a safe psychological space with no judgements being passed. SIM LEAGUES is not just a competition; it is an all-encompassing, exhilarating experience that expands your limits, grows your medical knowledge, and demonstrates the value of teamwork and communication. Most of all, it prepares you to handle real patients that you may encounter.



Crafting Realism in Medical Simulation

Introduction:

In the dynamic realm of medical education, simulation plays a pivotal role in preparing healthcare professionals for the challenges they may encounter in real-life scenarios. One crucial aspect of medical simulation is moulage, the art of creating realistic wounds and medical conditions on simulated patients. Moulage not only enhances the fidelity of simulations but also provides a hands-on, immersive experience for learners. This competition aims to celebrate the expertise and creativity of individuals in the field of moulage, recognizing their contributions to the advancement of medical education.

Competition Objectives:

To demonstrate and exhibit innovation in crafting realism through moulage, and its utility in diverse simulated clinical contexts.

Eligibility Criteria:

Each team shall comprise 3 members. One of the team members shall act as the simulated patient subject on the moulage will be applied. Team members should be a healthcare professional. There are no other restrictions or limitations on the composition of the teams. Teams can be interdisciplinary or interprofessional, and involve students too. Participating team members need not belong to the same institute.

Moulage Guidelines:

A standard set of moulage equipment / consumables including Corn starch, Vaseline, Coconut Oil, Paint, etc. will be provided. The moulage needs to be applied on one of your team members who will act as simulated patient. Candidates may request any specific arrangements for us to arrange which are within our scope, or bring their own. You will have 20 minutes to craft your moulage.

Judging Criteria:

Entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Realism and Detail: The extent to which the moulage designs authentically replicate medical conditions.

Educational Value: The effectiveness of the moulage in enhancing the learning experience for medical simulation participants.

Innovation: The creativity and originality demonstrated in the moulage designs.

Adaptability: The versatility of moulage creations for application across various medical simulation scenarios.

Ethical Considerations: Adherence to ethical standards and the promotion of a safe and supportive learning environment.
