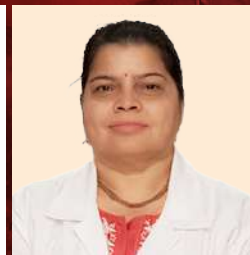

## Preparation and Submission of Abstracts

- ▶ **Language:** Abstracts must be written in English.
- ▶ **Template:** Authors must prepare abstracts using the official SOCACON 2026 Abstract Template.
- ▶ **Format:**
  - **File format:** Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx).
  - **Font:** Times New Roman.
  - **Font size:** 12 point (Title: 14 point, bold, centred).
  - **Line spacing:** Single.
  - **Paper:** A4 size, portrait orientation, with 1-inch (2.5 cm) margins on all sides.
- ▶ **Content Structure:**
  - Title:** Concise, clear, in ALL CAPITALS, bold, and centred.
  - Authors:** Full names in the correct order. Underline the presenting author and mark the corresponding author with an asterisk (\*).
  - Institutions:** Full institutional affiliation and address of all authors, centred.
  - Email:** Email address of the presenting author, centred.
  - Abstract Text:** Must be structured as:
    - \* Introduction (context and purpose)
    - \* Methods (study design, methodology, statistical tests)
    - \* Results (main findings)
    - \* Conclusion (summary, significance, implications)
    - \* Trial Registration (if applicable, include registry name and number).
- ▶ **Word Limit:** The abstract should not exceed 250 words (excluding title, authors, and affiliations).
- ▶ **Restrictions:** Abstracts must not include figures, tables, images, citations, or references.
- ▶ **Submission:** All abstracts must be submitted through the SOCACON 2026 Abstract Submission Form no later than 1st January 2026.

## Reviewing Process and Notification

- Each submitted abstract will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee.
- An acknowledgement of receipt will be sent within 5 days of submission. If not received, please contact: [scientific2026socacon@gmail.com](mailto:scientific2026socacon@gmail.com).
- The presenting author will be notified of the review outcome. If revisions are required, the revised abstract must be resubmitted within 7 days.
- The final notification of acceptance will be issued by 31st January 2026 via email.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to make the final decision regarding acceptance and the mode of presentation (oral or poster). Author preferences will be considered but not guaranteed.

# Visa Information for International Delegates

The Society of Clinical Anatomists (SOCA) and the Organising Committee feel truly blessed to invite you to the World Congress of Clinical Anatomists – SOCACON 2026. For international attendees, please review the following visa information carefully.

If you're visiting India to attend our conference, you need to obtain a Conference Visa instead of a Tourist Visa. A Conference visa is usually valid for 6 months from the time of issue and also permits tourism.

## Eligibility Criteria

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) specifies the eligibility criteria for a Conference visa as follows:

- ▶ Whose sole objective of visiting India is to attend a conference/seminar or workshop being held in India;
- ▶ Who holds a valid passport, and a re-entry permit if that is required under the law of the country of nationality of the applicant;
- ▶ Who is not a persona-non-grata to the Government of India;
- ▶ Who is not considered an undesirable person and is not the subject of a negative list or any warning circular or other restrictive list; and
- ▶ Who is a person of assured financial standing (the production of a return ticket and availability of sufficient money to spend during his stay in India may be considered sufficient for this purpose).

## Application Process for Visa

- ▶ If you're interested in applying for a Visa, you must fill our official form with your details AOE. It collects details essential for the organisers of SOCACON 2026 to obtain clearance from the Government of India.

## Required Documents

You must then obtain the following documents before applying for the Conference visa:

### Conference invitation letter

You will receive this via email as soon as you register for the conference. This letter will be provided to those who fill out the form.

### Clearance letter from MEA

Required for proceeding with visa applications in the concerned consulate

### Clearance letter from MHA

Required for some countries or travel logistics
